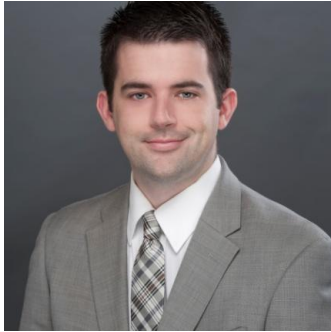


New Director of Government Affairs at Messenger Courier Association of America
